4MB Swimming Lessons: Autumn/Spring Term

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of the National Curriculum, all children are required to take part in swimming lessons in school by the age of eleven. Swimming lessons have been arranged on the following dates:

Class 4MB – Monday 4th December 2023 until Monday 18th March 2024

Lessons will take place at Lewsey Swimming Pool, and children will walk to the venue. In bad weather children may be transported via our school minibus.

Children will need the following:

- A towel
- Swimming costume/trunks (**Boys' swimwear needs to be above knee height and girls' a one-piece costume**)
- A swim cap covering long hair.
- Leagrave swim caps are available for £1.50 and can be purchased via your child's Scopay account.

The swimming sessions are part of the National Curriculum and therefore compulsory to attend. All children are expected to participate unless they have a medical reason which prevents them from doing so (a letter from your Doctor confirming the situation will be required in such cases).

A contribution of £24.00 is required to cover the cost for these sessions during the Autumn term. Payments must be made online via the Scopay system and can be made in two instalments if required:

£10.00 payment by Friday 1st November 2023

£14.00 payment by Friday 8th March 2024
