



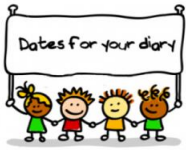

AUTISM & ARFID (AVOIDANT RESTRICTIVE FOOD INTAKE DISORDER) PARENT/CARER WEBINAR

With Ursula Philpot
Clinical Lead (Eating Disorders) NHS England

Join Ursula, Consultant Dietitian and Senior Lecturer, who specialises in eating disorders and disordered eating, with particular expertise in ARFID (Avoidant Restrictive Food Intake Disorder), including how it can present alongside autism and complex mental health needs.

In this session, Ursula will explore how eating difficulties can affect autistic children and young people, and how parents can best support them.

The session will cover:

- Understanding ARFID and its nutritional impact
- The sensory and psychological factors involved in eating difficulties
- When autistic eating differences may reach the ARFID threshold
- Diagnosis and assessment of ARFID
- Treatment approaches and support strategies
- Nutritional concerns and maintaining health
- Practical tips for supporting your child's food intake

This session aims to help parents better understand ARFID and feel more confident supporting their child with eating challenges.
